Those present were Vice-Chairman Ken Tipton, Commissioners Ron Cerri, Jesse Hill, and Tom Hoss, Deputy District Attorney Wendy Maddox, County Manager Dave Mendiola and Clerk of the Board Tami Rae Spero. Chairman Jim French was not in attendance.

Clerk Spero reviewed the results for the Commission including the pre and post logic and accuracy testing processes, the Voter Verifiable Printer verification process, the machine malfunction that occurred in the Paradise Valley precinct with the identified responses to said issue and an issue with voters being unable to vote in the Paradise Valley precinct and the response to said issue. Deputy Koepke responded to a query from Commissioner Hoss related on automatic voter registration. After discussion the following motion was made by Commissioner Hill and passed with Vice-Chairman Tipton and Commissioner Cerri, Hill and Hoss voting aye and Chairman French being absent:
