Meeting Minutes

Those present were Chairman Jim French, Commissioners Ken Tipton, Ron Cerri (via Teams), Jesse Hill (via Teams) and Tom Hoss, Deputy District Attorney Wendy Maddox, County Manager Dave Mendiola and Clerk of the Board Tami Rae Spero.

CALL TO ORDER: Chairman French called the special meeting to order in the regular place of meeting at the County Meeting Room #201, Courthouse, Winnemucca, Nevada.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Chairman French asked for public comment; none offered.

COUNTY CLERK: CANVASS OF THE RECOUNT RESULTS FOR GOVERNOR'S RACE FOR THE JUNE 14, 2022

PRIMARY ELECTION: Consideration, discussion, and possible approval to accept canvass of the recount results for Governor's race for the June 14th, 2022 Primary Election Returns for all precincts and districts within Humboldt County as requested by candidate, Joey Gilbert, and cause the Clerk to certify the abstract of the votes cast in said election as required by NAC 293.365, NRS 293.393, and NRS 293.395. Provided to the Commission at the meeting for review was a copy of the proposed Canvass and Abstract of the Vote of Humboldt County, State of Nevada 2022 Primary Election Recount Held June 30, 2022 including a Recount Comparison and Abstract of the Vote for the 2022 Primary Election Gubernatorial Recount showing no variation from the Canvass of Vote for the June 14, 2022 Primary, a copy of the certification of results signed by the duly appointed Recount Board, a copy of the Election Summary Report for the Recount of the Gubernatorial Race between Joey Gilbert and Joe Lombardo and a copy of the Statement of Votes Cast for the same Recount (see attached). Clerk Spero reviewed the request for Canvass for the Commission noting that there were no discrepancies between the results as Canvassed on June 24, 2022 for the Primary Election of June 14, 2022 and the results produced as a result of the recount done on June 30, 2022. Commissioner Cerri asked how the cost for the recount would be covered. Clerk Spero explained that the candidate seeking the recount had to deposit the estimated costs for the recount and a claim would be made against that deposit; she noted that the cost was less than the estimate produced by Humboldt County as the estimate was for the full five days allowed for the recount but the actual process had only taken about a half of a day. Chairman French asked Commissioners Cerri and Hill if they would approve Manager Mendiola signing in their stead as they were not appearing in-person. Deputy District Attorney Maddox asked if Commissioners Cerri and Hill had been emailed copies of the Canvass Report provided at the meeting. Clerk Spero indicated that they had not as she had not been aware that they would not be attending the meeting in-person. Deputy District Attorney Maddox asked that copies of the information be e-mailed to the Commissioners. Clerk Spero confirmed that she




