## **COVID, FLU VACCINES FREE OF CHARGE DURING IMMUNIZE NEVADA'S WALK-UP CLINIC**

WINNEMUCCA, Nev.— Immunize Nevada will host a COVID-19 and Flu Vaccine Clinic on February 22 in Winnemucca.

The walk-up clinic at the Pleasant Senior Center, 1480 Lay Street, will take place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Participants should use the senior center's front door; masks must be worn at all times.

The clinic will offer first and second doses of the Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines for persons age 5 and older. Boosters will be available for persons age 12 and older. All COVID-19 vaccines will be offered at no cost.

In addition, standard and high dose influenza shots will be available. Flu shots are recommended through May. Those with health insurance, including Nevada Checkup and Medicaid, should bring their insurance card; those without health insurance will receive the flu vaccine free of charge.

No appointment is necessary and no identification is required. Counselors in English and Spanish will be available to provide information. Participants should bring their vaccine card for updating.

Persons with COVID-like symptoms, or who are in quarantine, or who are currently awaiting COVID-19 test results, should not attend.

Those who test positive for COVID-19 will need to postpone getting vaccinated until their symptoms have resolved and they have met the criteria for discontinuing isolation. This timeline can vary by person, depending on the severity of symptoms and any treatments received. Residents are encouraged to consult with their medical provider.
